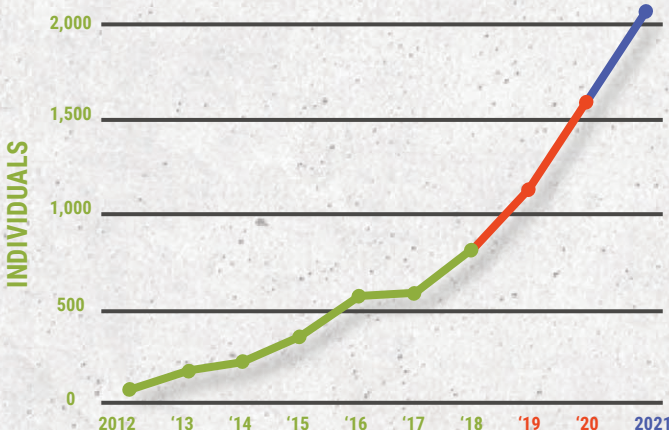

YOUR GIFT PROVIDES SAFETY AND STABILITY

- » 7 out of 10 individuals have experienced or witnessed domestic violence
- » 100% subsist below the federal poverty level or are severely low income upon entry into the program
- » 86% of parents leave the program employed with greater financial stability
- » 2 years after opening the Family Hope Center, 96% more parents and kids receive the help they need each year to become stable

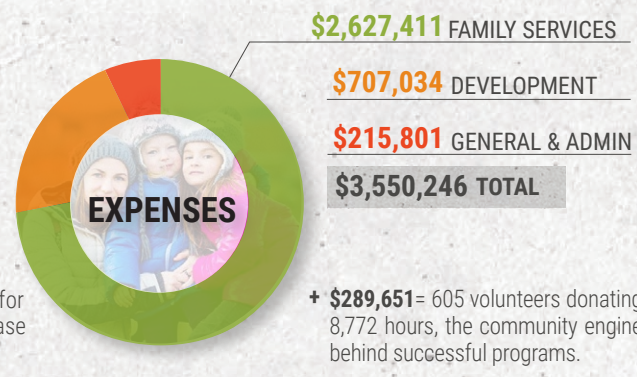
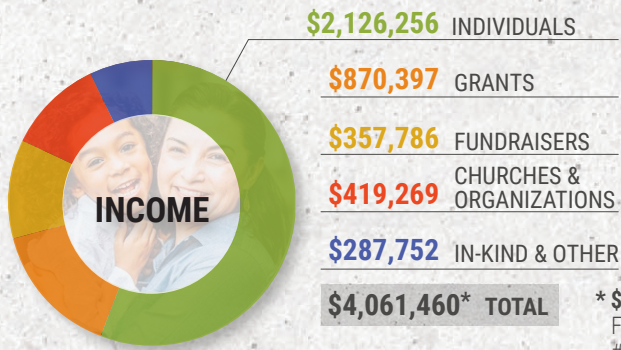

2020 HIGHLIGHTS » WHAT'S NEW



» **Hot Meals Program Pilot**
12,267 meals served to provide regular meals to parents and kids to address food scarcity that homeless families experience until they become stable.



» **Safety to Stability**
90% safely housed at exit – 220 families served in programs monthly – a 45% increase since COVID-19. As needed, supplement move-in costs and rent assistance for homeless and near-homeless families.



» **Technology**
100% classes shifted to online and onsite. Worked closely with families for internet access for connecting with employment, their supportive community, and schooling for their children.



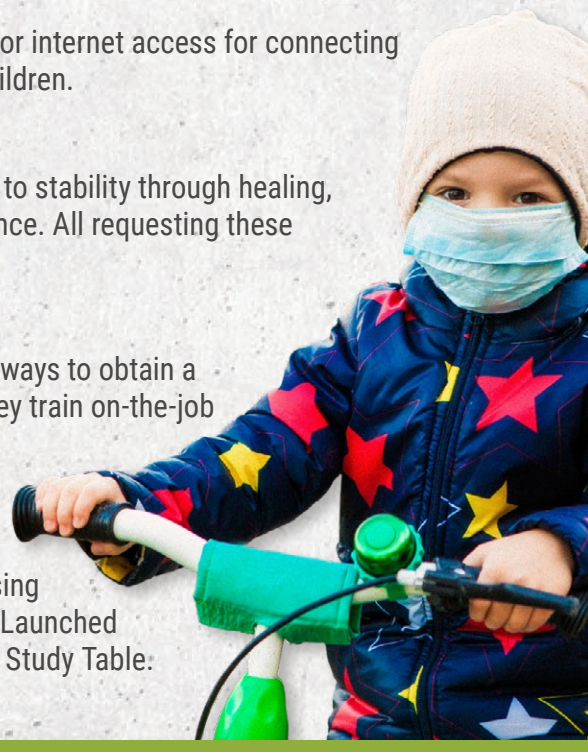
» **Behavioral Health & Counseling Pilot**
273 families engaged in counseling and workshops for reducing barriers to stability through healing, healthy boundaries, coping skills, parenting and reducing domestic violence. All requesting these services received them.



» **Workforce Development Pilot**
485 adults participated in employment programs focused on career pathways to obtain a livable wage job. Clients received scholarship and housing support as they train on-the-job and attend school for certifications, bridging them to employment.



» **Child & Youth**
1,033 kids received housing services, and 513 worked to develop social-emotional learning (SEL), focused on healing from trauma, increasing coping skills, and engaging in healthy relationships at home and school. Launched Preschool, Girls and Boys Mentoring Program, online Tutoring and teens' Study Table.



LOOKING FORWARD » MEETING THE COMMUNITY NEED

- » Serving more than 2,077 parents and children annually, the Family Hope Center will exceed capacity in 2021.
- » To meet the need, we plan to expand our services with a second facility in our service area.
- » Raising funds necessary to serve every family calling for help by expanding the footprint of the successful Stable Families Program.
